The 2nd Dakar Financing Summit hosted by the African Union Development Agency – New Partnership for Africa's Development (AUDA-NEPAD) on 1–3 February 2023 in Dakar, Senegal was held. Approximately 1,200 people involved in African infrastructure have attended.

At the summit, ambassador HORIUCHI made a presentation about (1) Japan-Africa partnership through Tokyo International Conference on African Development (TICAD), (2) Japan's contribution to PIDA (Africa Infrastructure Development Programme), (3) sound development finance, the need for global governance including the rule of law.
